Please type all responses and print the complete packet. Submit completed application in .pdf format by mail to our district office in Danville, IN or by email to in04AcademyNoms@mail.house.gov or hand deliver to the Danville district office by November 14, 2025 at 5:00 PM ET. Late applications will not be accepted.

For your application packet to be considered, you must follow the process outlined here. Failure to follow the instructions below may result in possible non-consideration of your materials. For email submissions, submit the following in **ONE** email to in04AcademyNoms@mail.house.gov, hand deliver, or mail your materials to the Danville district office located at 355 S. Washington St, Suite 210, Danville, IN 46122. If you are submitting via email, you must name the documents as designated in the parenthesis below e.g. (NB_Application) with the first two letters being your first and last initials.

Recommendation letters must be mailed to our district office in Danville, IN or scanned and emailed directly to our office from the person completing the recommendation at in04AcademyNoms@mail.house.gov and **CANNOT BE INCLUDED BY YOU IN YOUR PACKET.** Any letters submitted with your packet will not be considered, even if resent by the recommender. When I have received a letter of recommendation for you, I will email you to let you know it has been received.

Please know, our application deadline is **November 14, 2025, at 5:00 PM ET**. This means I must have every document for your application before that time – including recommendation letters and ACT/SAT scores. Do not wait until the last minute to request these items.

Application Agreement

Thoroughly read the following before signing. Your signature indicates your agreement with the following statements. Your application will not be considered if not signed.

The information on this application and included in my packet is all true and correct to the best of my knowledge. It is my sincere desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy, and I fully intend to accept an appointment, if offered. I am a U.S. Citizen, or will be by July 1, 2026. I am or will be at least 17, but not yet 23 years of age (USMMA: 25 years of age) on July 1, 2026. I am unmarried, not pregnant and do not have any child support obligations. I am a legal resident of the 4th Congressional District of Indiana.

I request that Congressman Baird consider my application for a congressional nomination to the U.S. Service Academy or Academies I have indicated. I understand that by placing a rank number for any U.S. Service Academy on page 5, binds me to complete the entirety of that U.S. Service Academy's application for admission. This means if I do not complete the entire application to all ranked academies by January 30, 2026, I will not be eligible for a nomination from Congressman Baird. I authorize Congressman Baird to monitor my progress in seeking an appointment to an Academy, and hereby consent for the Academy to divulge information from my records for this purpose.

I waive the provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974 to allow the sharing of information with the Service Academies and their representatives, as well as members of Congressman Baird staff and the 4th District Academy Nomination Advisory Board. I hereby authorize these parties to disclose, discuss, inspect, and copy any information regarding my application and information provided. I also authorize and release any third parties to discuss/disclose any information to verify my prior employment, activities, or criminal history.

I have read this entire application and all required material included. I understand I must submit my signed and completed application to in04AcademyNoms@mail.house.gov by the **5:00 PM ET**November 14, 2025 deadline. If not submitted by this time, I understand that my application will not be considered.

I understand that all communication with Congressman Baird and his staff is to be considered professional and should be conducted through emailing in04AcademyNoms@mail.house.gov. My correspondence with the office will be evaluated along with my application and other materials. I will be patient with Congressman Baird's staff, and honor a 24-hour response window on weekdays, and a 72 hour response window on weekends. If I have not had a response in those time periods, I then can contact the office for a second time.

I understand that all information in Congressman Baird's file related to my application, including but not limited to recommendation forms, evaluation forms and notes, is privileged and not accessible to the candidate. I have not tampered with test scores, transcripts or other documents submitted with my completed application.

In the event I receive a nomination, I authorize Congressman Baird's office to release this information to the news media and public. I also acknowledge my nomination is contingent on the completion of my applications to the service academies. Likewise, in the event I receive and accept an offer of appointment, I authorize Congressman Baird's office to release this information to the news media and public.

It is my sincere desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy. I understand that by attending a service academy I will be required to fulfill an obligation of five years of military service following graduation. I fully commit to this requirement and responsibility.
