

GET THE FACTS The One Big Beautiful Bill Act

Myth

The One Big Beautiful Bill is a tax break for billionaires.

This bill hurts small businesses.

SNAP work requirements are unnecessary.

The One Big Beautiful Bill kicks American families off Medicaid.

The One Big Beautiful Bill will close rural hospitals.

This punishes vulnerable Americans with work requirements to receive their benefits.

Fact

The One Big Beautiful Bill provides the largest middle- and working-class tax cut in U.S. history, putting more than \$10,000 a year back into the pockets of typical hardworking families. Low-income workers will see the largest percentage reduction in their tax liability through this pro-growth, pro-worker, and pro-family legislation.

The One Big Beautiful Bill will make the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act permanent, including the 199A Small Business Deduction, helping Main Street grow and hire. Failure to pass this bill would have resulted in a \$4 trillion tax hike.

Only 28% of able-bodied adults on SNAP work, indicating a failure of the program to fulfill its mission. The One Big Beautiful Bill aims to restore SNAP to help those in genuine need, as almost three-quarters of able-bodied adults without dependents on the program have no earned income.

This bill strengthens Medicaid for those who need it. Specifically, pregnant women, children, seniors, people with disabilities, and low-income families. It removes waste, fraud, and abuse. The One Big Beautiful Bill removes illegal immigrants, enforces work requirements, and protects Medicaid for the truly vulnerable.

This legislation creates the Rural Health Transformation Program to provide funding to states and covered facilities, including a wide array of small, rural, and Medicare-dependent hospitals and rural health clinics. Additionally, states and providers have relied on gimmicks like provider taxes and statedirected payments for years to draw down excessive federal funds and offset other state expenses. The bill puts a stop to these gimmicks by prohibiting any new ones from being put in place, but states and hospitals that already have these in place will see no changes. Further, the bill provides certainty for doctors by boosting their reimbursement and allows for larger future payment updates.

The work requirements in the One Big Beautiful Bill ask recipients to work, volunteer, study, or participate in job training for 20 hours per week. This requirement applies only to non-disabled adults without young children and promotes dignity, stability, and better health outcomes for families. These work requirements have broad bipartisan support.

WHAT DOES **THE BILL DO?**

The One Big Beautiful Bill delivers tax relief for hardworking Americans, the most secure border in recorded history, unleashes American energy, supports Rural America, and delivers on the mandate of the American people.

Benefitting Rural America

- Improves standing livestock disaster programs.
- Expands crop insurance and increases reference prices.
- Saves two million family farms nationwide from a Death Tax increase, including over 6,800 family farms in Indiana's Fourth Congressional District.
- Invests \$100 billion in Rural Distressed Communities.
- Levels the playing field on the world stage for our farmers, ranchers, and producers.

Unleashes American Energy

- Promotes onshore and offshore oil and gas leases.
- Resumes leasing for energy production.
- · Supports domestic critical mineral mining development.
- Creates new jobs in the energy sector.

Securing The Border

- Permanently secures the border.
- Speeds up the removal and deportation of illegal immigrants.
- Hires 10,000 new ICE Enforcement and Removal officers, 1,000 new DHS criminal investigators, and 3,000 new Border Patrol agents.
- Funds the completion of the border barrier.
